**Volleyball Registration**

Attached you will find the following 7 forms: 1-Sport Sign-Up Form; 2-Risk Acknowledgement and Consent to Participate Form; 3-Student Athlete-Medical Information and Emergency Consent Form; 4-Physical Examination Form; 5-Code of Conduct for Players and Parents; 6-Student-Athlete Sportsmanship Pledge and 7-Parent/Guardian Sportsmanship Pledge

All forms need to be completed and turned in, with the fee, when you register your child for volleyball. The only exception is the Physical Examination Form. If your child is new to Christ King Athletics, this form MUST be based on a doctor's physical examination of your child that was performed ON OR AFTER APRIL 1, 2010. The Physical Examination Form is good for two years from the date of the physical examination. If your child is returning to Christ King Athletics and has a current Physical Examination Form on file with Mary Wagy, Membership Coordinator, this form does not need to be submitted. If you are not sure if your child's physical examination form is current, you can check with Mary Wagy at 414-476-9610 or pmwagy@att.net.

**NO CHILD CAN PARTICIPATE IN PLAYER EVALUATIONS, PRACTICES OR GAMES WITHOUT A CURRENT PHYSICAL EXAMINATION FORM ON FILE! NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Completed registration forms can be returned beginning Monday, May 16 from 6:30-7pm or 8-8:30pm in South Hall, before or after attending the Christ King Athletics General Meeting. Forms can also be returned to the Christ King School Office, anytime between May 17-June 8. In addition, forms can be mailed or dropped off at Mary Wagy's home at 2414 N 89<sup>th</sup> St, Wauwatosa.

### Player Evaluations

Children who are interested in playing volleyball for the '11 season need to put the days/times that are listed below on their calendars. This particularly applies to 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade athletes who want to be considered for "A" team play.

SUMMER VACATION IS NOT CONSIDERED AN EXCUSED ABSENCE FROM PLAYER EVALUATIONS FOR 7<sup>TH</sup> AND 8<sup>TH</sup> GRADE ATHLETES. IF YOUR CHILD IS UNABLE TO ATTEND THE PLAYER EVALUATIONS, HE/SHE WILL BE PLACED ON THE "B" TEAM! NO EXCEPTIONS!

**If a child quits at any time after the beginning of the player evaluations for his/her grade, the Athletic Committee reserves the right to administer various sanctions against the child and/or his/her parents, including but not limited to: 1-not allowing the student to participate in other sports at Christ King; 2-not allowing the student's parents to coach at Christ King and 3-imposing a fine on the student's parents.**

5<sup>th</sup> grade: Player evaluations will take place if there are enough players registered to comprise two teams, both boys and girls. Teams are divided with equal talent on both teams. You will be notified via email over the summer as to the number of teams for each gender.

6<sup>th</sup> grade: Both boys and girls teams will remain intact from the '10 season.

7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade: Player evaluations will take place to divide players onto an "A" team and a "B" team. Players will be placed on teams according to the talent that is demonstrated at the player evaluations. To be considered for "A" team play, a player MUST be present at the player evaluation.

All player evaluations will be held in the Christ King gym. The schedule for player evaluations is as follows:

\*Player evaluations for 7<sup>th</sup> grade boys will occur if there are enough players registered to divide into two teams. You will be notified via email over the summer to confirm whether or not the player evaluation will be held.

## **General Information**

Practices: 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade teams have 2-75 minute practices each week and 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade teams have 2-90 minutes practices each week. Athletes will be contacted by their coach following player evaluations and the coach will advise the athlete of the days/times that they will practice.

Games: 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade boys generally play league games on Friday evenings. 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade girls generally play league games on Saturday mornings and 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade girls generally play league games on Saturday afternoons.

Tournaments: 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade teams have the opportunity to play in two tournaments in addition to league play. 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade teams have the opportunity to play in three tournaments in addition to league play. Individual coaches are responsible for securing tournament play and registration. Additional fees may be incurred by individual teams for tournament play.

Player/Parent Commitment: Players are responsible for attending all practices and games in a timely manner. Parents are responsible for providing/arranging for their child's transportation to and from all practices and games. The same level of commitment is expected of all players, regardless of the team to which your child is assigned. Please take the commitment to play volleyball seriously. Please encourage your child to do the same.

Communication: My preferred method of communication is email. PLEASE ensure that an accurate and legible email address is provided on your Sport Sign-Up Form as you will receive updated information as the summer progresses. When your child is assigned to a team, coaches will then provide you with information that is specific to your team.
